Subject: Debarment of consultants / Civil Contractor by the Ministry and its implementing agencies- Applicability of court order.

Sir,

The matter of debarment of contractors / consultants was got deliberated in the Ministry and it is decided that-

1. Any entity which has been barred by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways or its implementing agencies for the works of Expressways, National Highways, Inter State Connectivity (ISC) and Economic Importance (EI) works, and the bar subsists as on the bid due date, would not be eligible to submit the bid, either individually or as member of a Joint Venture.
2. In case the debarred Agency brings court order to stay the debarment order issued by Public Authorities then this court order shall be followed till such time there is final outcome in the judicial proceeding.

3. In case the orders (interim or final) are applicable only in respect of a particular implementing Agencies, such debarment etc. will be applicable only to that Agency and will not have any bearing consequences, with reference to procurement being carried out by other Agencies.

This issue with the approval of competent authority and shall be followed by all implementing agencies i.e. State PWDs / NHAI / NHIDCL / BRO / IAHE.
