Dear Sir,

Hon'ble Prime Minister of India launched Digital Locker Platform on July 1, 2015. This Platform is called DigiLocker in case of product developed by the Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India through National e-Governance Division(now part of Digital India Corporation). Digilocker is an important building block cutting across all 3 vision areas of Digital India. So far, **38** Departments/Organizations have made available **over 197 crore** documents and **about 1 crore** DigiLocker accounts have been created as per the summary given in **Annexure-I** to this letter.

As an amendment to the Information Technology (Preservation and Retention of Information by Intermediaries Providing Digital Locker Facilities) Rules, 2016 notified on February 8, 2017 vide G.S.R. 711(E) (**Annexure-II**), Rule 9A was introduced, according to which the documents issued/pushed by various Departments/Organisations in DigiLocker system shall be deemed to be at par with original physical documents. Complete DigiLocker Rules can be seen at <http://digilocker.gov.in/resource/rules-and-Amendment.php>. The thrust of DigiLocker is to promote the vision of paperless governance, thus enabling any citizen to produce requisite documents any time anywhere in legally acceptable electronic form.

The State Government Departments/Organizations can participate in DigLocker as an Issuer or a Requestor or a Verifier of documents. Details of each of these roles are given in **Annexure-III**. In view of the above, it is requested that following action may be taken on priority basis.

- Various certificates issued by the State Governments/Organisations such as School Education Board Certificates, University Degrees, Ration Cards, Land Records,

Birth/Death/Donorship and other documents etc. are uniformly issued in digital form. It is proposed to carry out integration of these and other similar documents for be used to public at large with Digilocker. An illustrative list of potential documents/certificates which need to be brought on Digilocker is given in **Annexure-IV**. Though the documents issued to and accessed from Digilocker are legally acceptable, 3 alternative methods of verifications - QR Code, Digital Signature and Online Verification - also exist.

- State Departments/Agencies are encouraged to submit documents on their online portal and also become Requesters and accept documents from Digilocker without insisting on scanned/attested copies.
- In order to expedite the process of on boarding of various departments/organisations, NeGD has empanelled 18 agencies to carry out requisite technical work at a sum of Rs. 75,000 per integration and support. This cost of the integration shall be borne by NeGD. List of these empanelled agencies is attached in **Annexure-V**. If the Department/Organisation concerned decides to carry out this task of integration internally or through its existing manpower, a similar support up to the ceiling amount of Rs. 75,000 shall be provided.
- Even after two and a half years of launch of Digilocker, most of the enforcing authorities are still unaware about statutory provisions relating to acceptability of documents issued by various authorities through Digilocker. For example, even though Driving License and Vehicle Registration Certificates are integrated with Digilocker through National Register of **Vahan & Sarathi**, police personnel in some States are still not accepting the same due to lack of the knowledge about Digilocker. It is clarified that as per provisions of Rule 9A referred to above, provided that all certificates or documents accessed through the Digilocker - RI shall be treated in the same manner as original documents for all purposes.

You are, therefore, requested to adopt DigiLocker as a platform in a big way for providing authentic documents/certificates. Specific directions may also kindly be issued to all Departments/Organizations in your State to accept the documents shared through DigiLocker.

The Government of India had originally set out a goal of 5 crore Digilockers within 5 years from launch but a concerted & collective effort can help us cross that figure within a year or so once more Issuers come on board. Tentative break up of this target (including both Aadhaar seeded and non-seeded DigiLocker accounts) is given in **Annexure-VI**.
